



Paw Print Cookies

For Cookies:

- 1 3/4 cups flour
 - 1/2 tsp salt
 - 1 tsp baking soda
 - 1/2 cup butter, softened
 - 1/2 cup white sugar
 - 1/2 peanut butter
 - 1/2 cup brown sugar
 - 1 egg, beaten
 - 1 tsp vanilla extract
 - 2 tbs milk
- ## For Paw Prints:
- M&Ms
 - Mini Reese's cups



Get an adult to help you use the oven for this recipe

This recipe makes about 3 dozen cookies

1. Have an adult preheat the oven to 375°F.
2. Mix the flour, salt, and baking soda. Set aside.
3. Mix the butter, sugar, peanut butter, and brown sugar until fluffy.
4. Beat in the egg, vanilla, and milk.
5. Add the flour mixture from step 2 and mix well.
6. Roll dough into 1-inch balls, roll them in sugar so they are lightly coated, and place them onto a greased cookie sheet.
7. Bake at 375°F for 6-8 minutes. While you wait for the cookies to bake, unwrap your Reese's cups.
8. When the cookies are out of the oven, immediately press a mini Reese's cup and M&M's into each cookie to form a pawprint.
9. Once cooled, enjoy your creation!
